

Our church is committed to be a part of God's worldwide mission to spread the gospel of Jesus Christ and disciple the nations (Mathew 28:18-20).

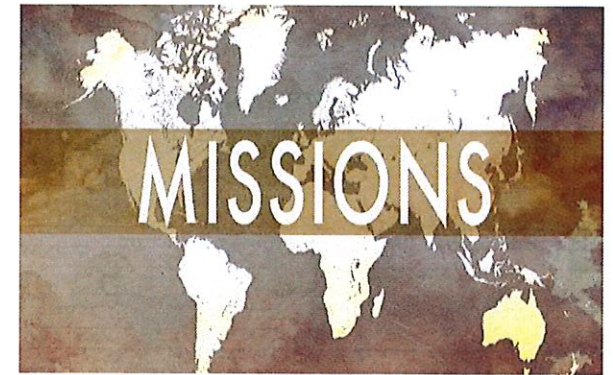
We believe that the building of the church at home is not an end in itself, but rather a means to a greater end – world evangelism.
